Brand Guide at a glance

Logo

Thunderbird's logo serves as the institution's visual identity and a cornerstone of its brand. As a distinctive piece of original artwork, the Thunderbird logo must remain unaltered, maintaining its integrity without modification, redrawing, or adaptation.

The primary identifier for the school is the full co-branded Thunderbird-ASU logo, which should be prominently featured across all official Thunderbird materials, including print and digital assets, as well as branded apparel and promotional items.

In exceptional cases, and only with prior written approval from Thunderbird's Office of Branding and Communications, the standalone Thunderbird logo—incorporating the ASU tagline, "A unit of the Arizona State University Enterprise"—may be used in either a horizontal or vertical orientation. In such instances, the symbol, wordmark, and ASU tagline must always appear together as a unified representation of the brand. However, when the Thunderbird logo is displayed alongside the ASU logo in its co-branded form, the ASU tagline is omitted.

Color palette

Thunderbird Blue, Gold and Gray are the school's primary colors. Over many years, Thunderbird has built brand equity in navy blue and gold. These two colors define who we are as an educational institution and all digital and multicolor print designs should lead with the primary brand colors.

The use of secondary colors should be done sparingly and with the intention, ideally adding meaning or clarity to the creative item. They should complement the primary brand color palette and are most helpful when used in charts, graphs and maps that may require several colors for clearer reading and comprehension.
