About the program

Thunderbird's accelerated master's program offers an accelerated pathway for Arizona State University (ASU) immersion undergraduate students to obtain a Master of Global Management (MGM) degree in only one year after a student's undergraduate graduation.

Choose one concentration, ranging from Global Business, Digital Transformation, Data Science (all STEM Designated) to Global Affairs, Health Solutions, Public Policy, and more. Thunderbird's one-of-a-kind Global Challenge Lab takes students into the field for a real-world, client-facing practical group project, during which they work full-time with a client in an international or domestic location.

This full-time accelerated graduate program prepares students with the skills necessary to lead diverse international teams in the private, public, and not-for-profit sectors. The accelerated MGM combines an ASU undergraduate degree with Thunderbird's Master of Global Management, enhancing students' global mindsets, skill sets, and marketability — all through just one additional year of study.
